WATER SAFETY POLICY

We hope that our members/hotel guests and visitors enjoy their swimming experience in the Aquila Club. Please read our water safety policy and adhere to these instructions for the safety of everyone.

WE TAKE SAFETY SERIOUSLY!

- 1. Parents and guardians, please be aware at all times that you are responsible for your children while in the Aquila Club pool.
- 2. Do not leave children unattended in the main pool while you attend to smaller children in the baby pool.
- 3. Do not leave children unattended in the baby pool or any other area of the Aquila Club.
- 4. This means that children u-14 must always be accompanied by an adult (over 18) in the water. 14 16 year olds must be supervised by an adult (over 18) from the viewing area.
- 5. We strongly advise the use of flotation devices such as armbands to ensure your child's safety whilst swimming.
- 6. Remember if the duration of your swimming session is over 1 hour, your child will become fatigued and this could affect their swimming capability.
- 7. Make sure your children understand competing to see who can hold their breathe underwater, and other similar games, can be dangerous and should not be part of any water-related activities. We strongly advise swimmers to inform our staff if they are performing any specific breathing or endurance exercises while in the pool.
- 8. Please observe the following additional water safety rules:
 - a. No running
 - b. No foul play
 - c. No diving into shallow end of pool
 - d. No photography/videography allowed
 - e. No glasses or crockery allowed
 - f. Lilo's, ball's, flippers, snorkels and any items that management feel are detrimental to pool water safety may not be permitted at busy times and management reserves the right to remove these items from the pool.
